

#### Tiny People, Big House: Rough Story Concepts



### Little People, Big House Overarching Story Concepts

Each of the concepts presented here will include the following elements:

- The Environment is downscaled so that objects appear larger. This will be in various rooms in a house and areas outside (including in a tree, in a garden, etc.).
- Castles/Fortresses are formed from household items (e.g. pencils, rulers, toys, garden tool, etc.).
- You launch household items such as wad of paper, a bundle of paperclips, bouncy rubber band ball and so on from a catapult made from household items (e.g. mouse trap with spoon).
- The Environment will have time-of-day lighting and seasonal attributes including:
  - Wind slightly alters the trajectory.
  - Snow weighs down projectiles.
  - Rain makes projectiles more slippery.
  - Lightning strikes where metal Ball lands.
- Soldier archetypes will include a basic soldier and a larger, harder to topple soldier.
- There will also be appropriately themed Attack Items an creatures that activate when hit such as:
  - A stationary explosive object.
  - A large, moving massive attack creature or object.
  - An object that swarms and only attacks the soldiers.
  - A stationary object that, when hit, dashes at the fortress.



# **Clan of Ittles vs. Rat Clan**

You are the Leader of the cute Clan of Ittles and have to defend your territory in the Human's House.

The cranky Rat Queen has set up fortresses and stocked them with her Rat Minion Soldiers to try and claim areas of the house as her own and capture your fellow Ittles.

You must fling items to destroy the Rat Queen's Castles and thwart her territorial takeover as well as free the Ittles.





## **Dust Bunnies vs. Hose-Nosed Soldiers**

You are a magical Dust Bunny and all your fellow Dust Bunnies have been captured by Hose-Nosed Soldiers.

They cannot stand the dust as it makes them sneeze uncontrollably so they try to contain the Dust Bunnies in make-shift prisons.

You must free your fellow Dust Bunnies and defeat the Hose-Nosed Soldiers keeping them captive.





# Sugar Gliders vs. Garden Gnomes

Your friends, family and fellow Sugar Glider buddies are disappearing.

The Garden Gnomes are jealous of the Sugar Glider's being able to soar through the skies, so they have taken them prisoner to stop the high-flying action.

You must free your fellow Sugar Gliders and knock down the mostly immobile Garden Gnomes.
